Who Took the Survey?



838 total responses

187 provided email address to stay informed about the planning effort

Q17, 18. Responses from every area of the city.

34.5% (n=238) from neighborhoods surrounding the park ---> +83% have moved to that neighborhood since the park was last master planned in 1987

10% (n=68) from outside the city

Frequent disc golfers (n=117)

Home backs up to the park (n=106)

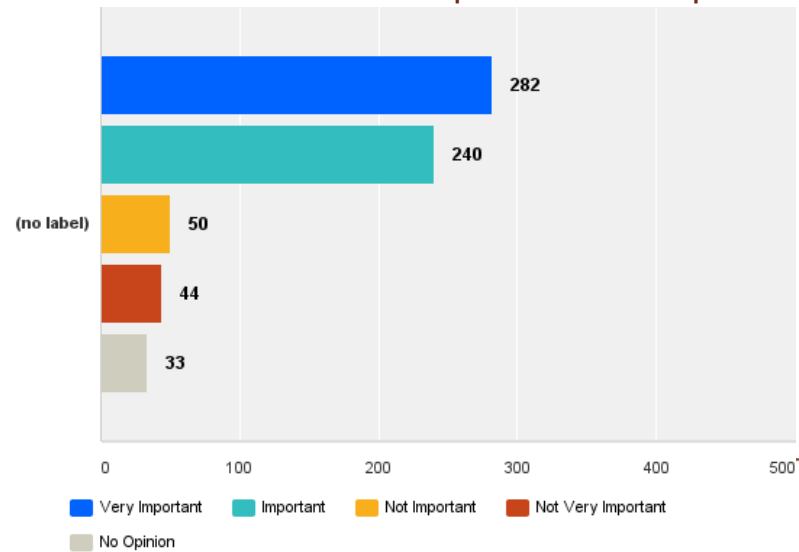

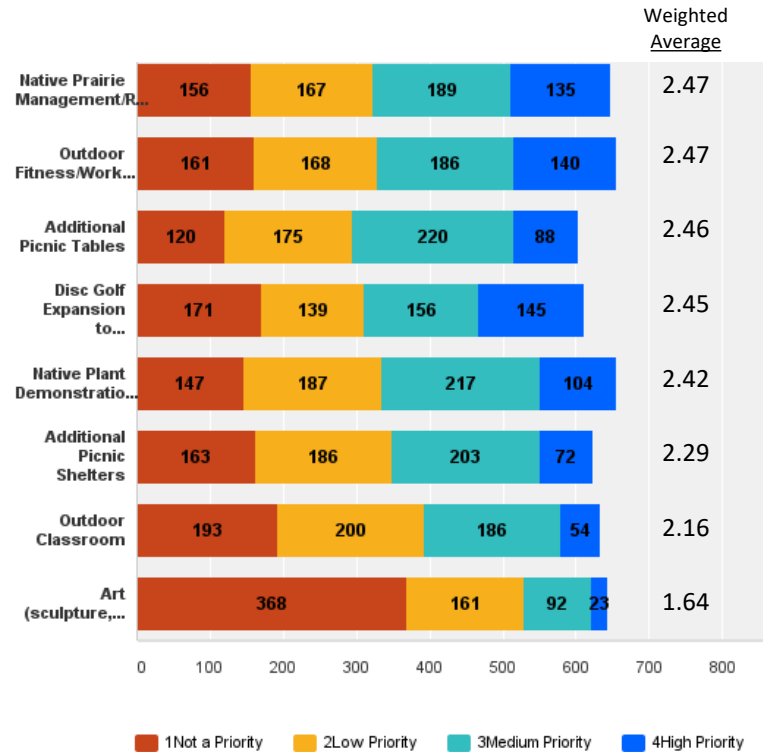
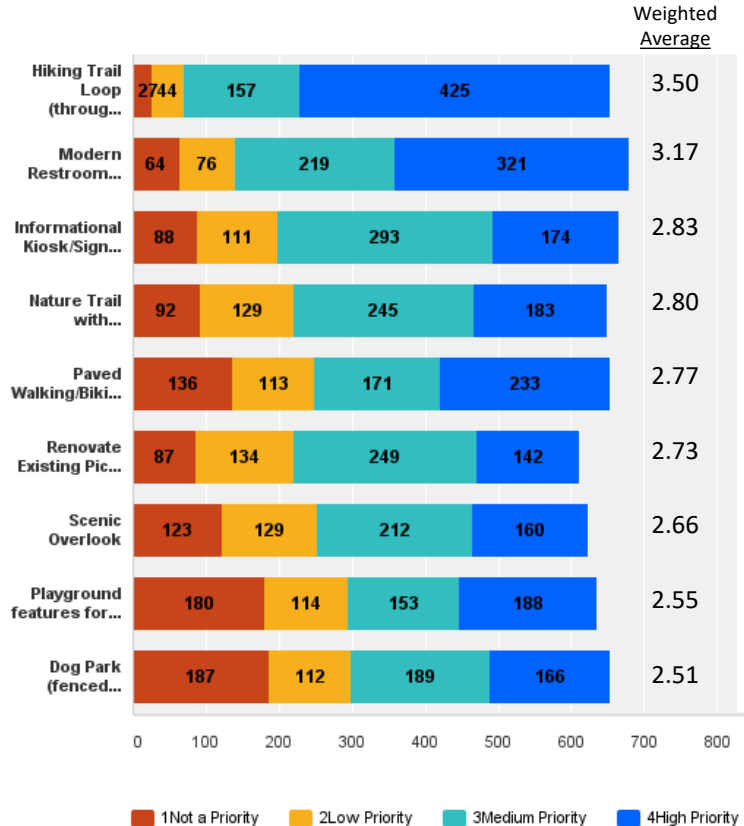
Q10: Please indicate what priority level you would assign to developing the following amenities in Warner Park:

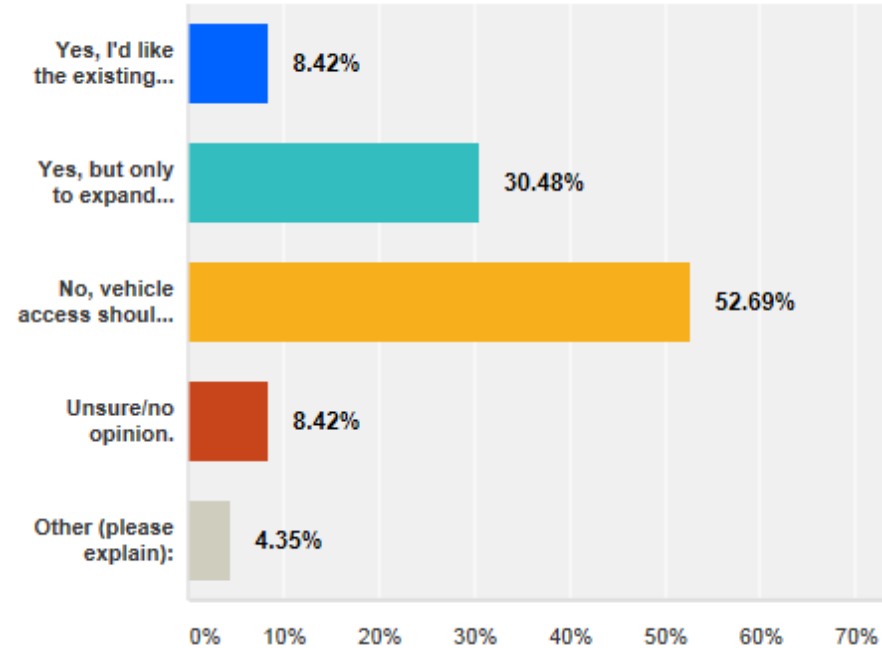

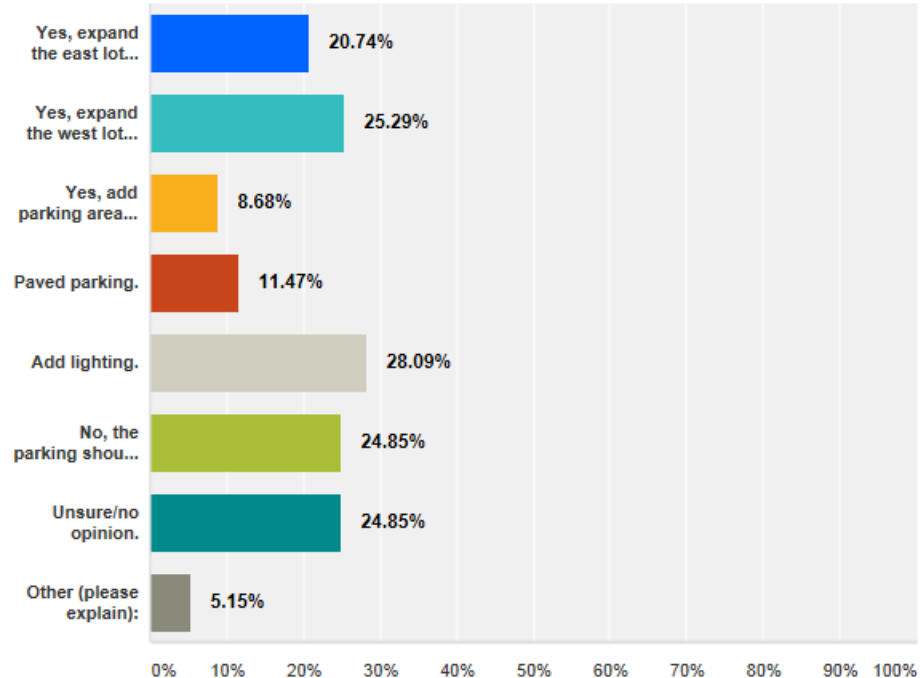
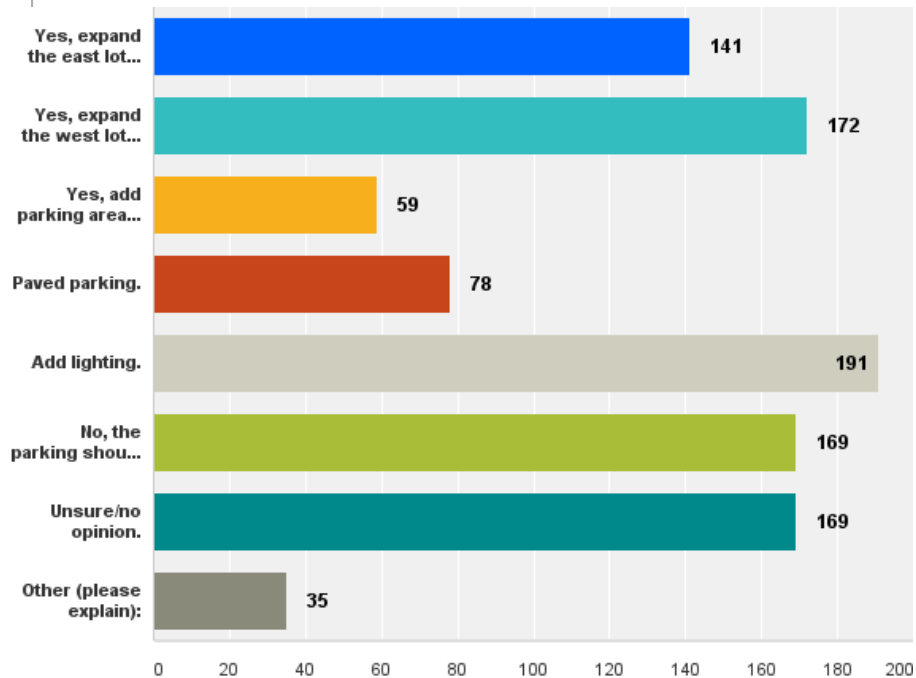
Q13: Should vehicle access be allowed in Warner Park?
