

Baggage Allowance

Each passenger departing Manhattan Regional is allowed:

- One personal item such as a purse (as long as it will fit under the passenger seat).
- One gate-checked bag (as long as the dimensions of that bag do not exceed: 22” long, 14” high and 9” wide, which are the typical size of a bag that fit in an overhead bin).

“Gate-Checked” means the airlines ground staff will take your bag from you as you come out to board and place it in the aircraft’s baggage compartment. Your bag will be waiting for you at the bottom of the stairs as you come off the aircraft.

Baggage restrictions vary from airline to airline. It is recommended that you check with your connecting airline if you are unsure about their requirements.

Charges, Dimensions, and Weight

- Dimension of checked bag is 62in. and weight of checked bag is 50 lbs.
- \$30 for the first checked bag
- \$40 for the second checked bag
- \$150 for the third checked bag
- \$200 for any additional pieces
- Checked bag over 50 lbs. will be charged at the rate of \$100 per piece.
- Checked bag over 70 lbs. will be charged at the rate of \$200 per piece.
- Checked bag larger than 62in will be charged at the rate of \$200 per piece.
