

## Prohibited Carry On Items

Generally speaking, prohibited items are any items that may be used as a lethal weapon. For more information about these new carry-on restrictions go to: [3-1-1](#).

The prohibited items list now includes liquids, gels, and aerosols. If you wish to take any of these items in your carry-on bag, their containers must not exceed 3 oz in size and must be stored in one (clear), quart size plastic zip lock bag. **Only one quart bag per passenger.** The quart bag must be placed in the carry-on baggage x-ray transport bin for screening prior to the passenger going thru the walk-thru metal detector.

Larger items, such as baby food, milk and prescription medications, do not have to be stored in a zip-lock bag, but their presence should be made known to TSA personnel.
